

# Precautionary Measures and Special Notices for Covid-19:

## Special Notices for Covid-19 (last update 2 DECEMBER 2020):

Competitors shall comply with any [HKSAR Government Covid-19 regulations](#) and RHKYC Covid-19 precautions in place at the time of the event.

Please refer here to current [access requirements to the Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club](#). Advice regarding the requirements will be updated on the event website and reiterated to all attendees to the event.

## Access to the Royal Hong Kong Yacht Club

- **all members** entering the Club must scan Government's the LeaveHomeSafe venue QR Code. If members do not have a smartphone with a QR reader, members must use the Club's own newly developed Health Declaration System by which they must tap their smartcard against a designated card reader to record their entry. An adult may scan for any accompanying children/members from the same household. Members may of course use both systems if they wish. Members who do not use one of these two systems will not be granted entry to the premises.
- **all non-members** entering any of our premises **must** scan the Government's LeaveHomeSafe venue QR code. An adult may scan for any accompanying children/members from the same household. There is no alternative mechanism available for non-members to use to enter the premises. Please ensure that your guests are prepared to use the government's system. Staff are authorised to prohibit entry to any person who does not comply with this request.
- **all members and non members** returning to the Club **after being out on the water**, **must** scan the Government's LeaveHomeSafe venue QR Code upon re-entering the Club, as per the applicable process listed above.

***Please do not come to the Club if :***

- You are suffering from any symptoms of the Covid-19 virus;
  - You or any member of your immediate household has been in close contact with a confirmed or provisionally confirmed Covid-19 patient in the last 14 days;
  - you or any member of your immediate household has returned from abroad in the past 14 days (unless exempt from compulsory Quarantine/Isolation under the HKSAR Government's scheme);
  - you or any member of your immediate household has been in close contact with anyone who has returned from abroad in the past 14 days, unless that person is exempt from compulsory Quarantine/Isolation under the HKSAR Government's scheme.

- Temperature checks will be conducted on all those entering Club premises. Anyone with a body temperature of 37.6C or higher shall be denied entry.
  - Members and guests must bring their own mask when coming to the Club
  - Food and beverage may only be consumed when at a table
  - Everyone must wear a mask on Club premises *except when eating/drinking, showering, swimming, exercising outdoors or in the gym or when bowling or playing squash, snooker or table tennis.*
  - Table sizes in restaurants may not exceed two per table effective 2 December
  - Members and their guests must ensure that they do not gather in groups of more than two at any time when on Club premises or on the sampans (unless they are a family group living in the same household).
  - Gathering rule – while ashore sailors will be spaced-out in sub-groups in order to meet the latest gathering rule

**Middle Island Sampan Service**

The Middle Island sampan will operate between the promenade steps and Middle Island pontoon. Whilst queuing for the sampan, please ensure that groups are no more than **2 persons, 1.5 metres apart and masks to be worn at all times**. Please note that our Race Permit is subject to all observing and strictly complying with the precautionary measures and guideline(s) for the prevention of spread of the COVID-19 as stipulated by under [Cap599F](#), [Cap599G](#), and [Cap599I](#).
